Day 1

Check out and depart back to Johannesburg where you will be transferred to the Michelangelo Hotel where you will spend the night.

Accommodation: The Michelangelo Hotel

Day 2

After breakfast this morning you will be transferred from your hotel to OR Tambo International Johannesburg Airport where you will connect to your South African Airways flight to Victoria Falls. Upon arrival in Victoria Falls you will be transferred to your hotel.

The Victoria Falls Hotel was built in 1904 when the planned Cape to Cairo railway reached the Victoria Falls. It is set in the Victoria Falls National Park with a private path to the Victoria Falls. The hotel has an atmosphere steeped in history, combining the charm of the old with the comfort and convenience of today. With its old world charm, guests are assured of a memorable stay in what is undoubtedly one of the few remaining hotels of its kind in the world.

The hotel's guest rooms are equipped with air-conditioning, satellite television, mini-bars in suites, complimentary early morning tea/coffee, telephone, safe, 24-hour room service, bathrobes, hairdryer and umbrellas for personal use during your stay. The hotel features a restaurant which offers a variety of cuisine. Hotel facilities include a swimming pool, a private path to the falls, laundry service, disabled accommodation, care hire and touring desks, baby sitting services, hair salon, and beauty therapist, doctor on call, library, foreign exchange facilities, telex, E-lounge, and curio shop. Set in acres of lush lawns and exotic flora; enjoy a wonderful view of the Falls and acres of gardens as you sit on the porch. The hotel is only a few minutes walk from the center of Victoria Falls Town and a ten-minute walk along the hotel's private path from the actual Falls.

Included with this package is a **"Dine Around" voucher** for both nights in Victoria Falls.

Day 3

After breakfast a guided **tour of Victoria Falls**, one of seven natural wonders of the world. This walking safari takes you through the magnificent rain forest where you are able to view the Cataracts, Livingstone's statue and a wide variety of birds and plants.

Finish off the afternoon with a **sunset cruise** on the Zambezi River. After returning to the hotel, enjoy another dinner at one of the many restaurants available with your "Dine Around" vouchers.

Please Note:

- **United States of America** passport holders **require a visa for Zimbabwe** which is obtainable on arrival at the point of entry.
- We strongly advise you to **take precautions against malaria** prior to the commencement of your holiday. Please contact your physician or travel clinic for advice as to which prophylactic is recommended.
- **PASSPORTS:** Please ensure that you are in possession of **a valid passport** with at least **THREE BLANK PAGES** marked "VISA" (two for South Africa and one for Zimbabwe) and that it is **valid for at least 6 months** after your intended return date from Southern Africa.
- **ZIMBABWE:** For **United States of America** passport holders, payment of **Single Entry Visas** is **US\$30**, **Double Entry Visas**, **US\$45** and **Multiple Entry Visas**, **US\$55**. We recommend the exact amount in cash, as officials are not always in a position to give change.
- **Zimbabwe Currency:** All monetary transactions in Zimbabwe are now in US Dollars. You are advised to carry USD CASH when travelling through Zimbabwe. Hotels will only accept US\$ notes printed after 2001.
- **Credit Cards in Victoria Falls:** Visa credit cards are now accepted in all hotels in Zimbabwe. Guests can also withdraw from an ATM with a visa card for a maximum of USD 400 per day. Other cards are still not widely accepted.
- **Zimbabwe Airport Tax:**
Zimbabwean authorities have introduced a new airport tax, which will be used to upgrade the airports. A USD 30 per person departure tax is payable directly at the airports from 01 April 2011.
