Walk on the Wild and Savagely Beautiful Side of Africa. Drive among Africa's wildlife including elephant, lion, leopard, giraffe, erenuk, antelope, ostrich, zebra, chimpanzee and onyx. Enjoy the magnificent views of majestic Mount Kenya the Ol Pejeta Conservancy and Masai Mara National Reserve.

Day 1

On arrival at Nairobi's Jomo Kenyatta International Airport you will be met by a Lion World Tours/Gutsy Women Travel representative and transferred to your Nairobi Hotel. Overnight at The Tribe Hotel on a bed and breakfast basis which brings you into a world of hip, chic design with an emphasis to detail and luxury and is situated in the up-market Gigiri suburb of Nairobi.

Day 2

After breakfast you will visit the Karen Blixen Museum and Giraffe Centre as well as the Daphne Sheldrick Elephant Orphanage. Return to your hotel where you will have an opportunity to enjoy some souvenir shopping at the Maasai Market in the Village Market shopping center.

Overnight: The Tribe Hotel (Breakfast, Dinner)

Day 3

Today we drive from Nairobi to the Samburu National Reserve. Rugged and remote, this wildlife reserve provides some of the best and most colorful game viewing in the country. Lunch will be at your Camp, Samburu Intrepids Camp, a luxury-tented camp in the midst of the most rugged and savagely beautiful semi-arid dessert of northern Kenya. After lunch, depart on an afternoon game drive.

Overnight: Samburu Intrepids Camp (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 4

Enjoy twice-daily game drives with resident guides. The camp's location guarantees close encounters with the region's wildlife, including elephant, lion, leopard, and Samburu's famous 'unique five' - the rare reticulated giraffe, long-necked gerenuk antelope, Somali ostrich, Grevy's zebra, and majestic Beisa Oryx. A unique activity on offer at Samburu is the camel back safari (optional, for own account.)

Overnight: Samburu Intrepids Camp (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 5

After breakfast, drive to the Mount Kenya Safari Club situated in the shadow of Mt Kenya, Kenya's highest mountain. You will arrive there in time for lunch. The rest of the day will be spent at leisure, enjoying the clubs facilities, such as horse riding, golf, swimming etc. You may also visit the animal orphanage managed by the neighboring ranch and the William Holden Foundation. Access to the orphanage is located next to the main gate and the Art Gallery (optional, for own account.)

Overnight: Fairmont Mount Kenya Safari Club (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 6

Today we drive to the Ol Pejeta Conservancy. Arrival will be in time for lunch. Thereafter depart on an afternoon game drive, where you will have the opportunity to visit the famous Jane Goodall Chimpanzee Sanctuary. Return to your camp for dinner and overnight at the upscale Sweetwaters Tented Camp which lies in the heart of privately owned Sweetwaters Game Reserve, enjoying magnificent views across the game-studded plains to the snow-capped peaks of Mount Kenya.

Overnight: Sweetwaters Tented Camp (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 7

After breakfast transfer to Nanyuki Airstrip for your scheduled flight to the luxurious Masai Mara National Reserve nestled in a forest on a site originally reserved exclusively for the colonial Governors of Kenya. Upon arrival at the airstrip you will be met by vehicles from Main Governors Camp and transferred to your camp with a game drive en route.

Overnight: Main Governors Camp (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 8

Early morning and afternoon game drives in the Masai Mara National reserve. Your meals and overnight are at Main Governors Camp. The Masai Mara National Reserve offers wonderful scenery of breathtaking vistas, panoramas of vast rolling plains, hills and woodland groves, well watered by the lovely Mara River. The Mara is home to the largest population of lions in Kenya; these magnificent beasts spend most of the day sleeping in the shade of Acacia Trees.

Overnight: Main Governors Camp (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 9

Spend another day of early morning and late afternoon game viewing in the Masai Mara. The great herds of shuffling elephants browse among the rich tree-studded grasslands with an occasional sighting of a solitary rhino. Thomson's and Grant's gazelle, topi and eland and many more species of plains' game offer a rich choice of food for the dominant predators; lion, leopard and cheetah which hunt in this pristine wilderness. In the Mara River hippos snort and grumble, while seemingly drowsy crocodiles sunbathe on the river banks.

Overnight: Main Governors Camp (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Day 10

After an early morning game drive, transfer to the airstrip for your scheduled flight to Nairobi. Upon arrival you will transfer to your Nairobi hotel for a dayroom and relaxation at the Fairmont Norfolk Hotel. Later, you will be transferred to the Karen Blixen Coffee Garden for a late lunch. Then transfer to Jomo Kenyatta International Airport for your departure flight.
